



How to Make Your Own Dreidel

Materials Needed:

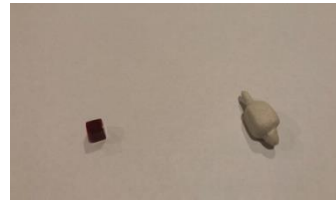
- Old-fashioned, square glass saltshaker (or square bead for a smaller dreidel)
- Air-dry clay (can use Polymer clay)
- Paint or markers to decorate

Directions:



Cover the saltshaker with a block of clay (left)

For a smaller dreidel, use a square bead instead (right)



Pull on clay to shape the lower half. Do not make a sharp point as the dreidel will not spin well (left)

Air dry the clay for several days (or bake according to directions if using polymer clay)

When clay's dry, draw the four Hebrew letters (below) on each side of the dreidel and decorate as desired

The four Hebrew letters and their names:

נ ג ה ש
Nun Gimmel Hey Shin
